As a small parish council, we focus on practical, proportionate actions that make a meaningful difference to local residents.

How We Promoted Equality and Inclusion in year ending March 2026

- **Working with partner organisations** — The Council has collaborated with service providers to ensure that activities are available to residents from diverse backgrounds and with differing needs including the Wrose summer music festival which showcased young music talent.
- **Supporting early years and family inclusion** — Through initiatives such as *Play in the Park events*, we helped create safe, accessible spaces where children and families from across the community can come together and participate in free, inclusive activities.
- **Supporting residents living with dementia** — We provided support to community organisations that provide dementia-friendly activities that help to reduce isolation and improve wellbeing for residents and their carers.
- **Grant funding for inclusive community activity** — Our grants programme supported local groups that promote health, wellbeing, and active lifestyles for all residents, including those who may face barriers to participation.
- **Accessible communication** — The Council works closely with its website provider to ensure that online information meets current accessibility standards and complies with the required accessibility statement. We aim to make our communications clear, easy to navigate, and usable by all residents.
